Dear St. Gabriel's Parishoners:

This 1948 Spiritual and Financial Report goes to you with a prayer of thanksgiving to our Blessed Lord, His Immaculate Mother, St. Gabriel and St. Joseph for the many spiritual and temporal blessings they have showered upon the parish during the past year. Without their continuous help our parish could not exist.

In looking over the financial report of the individual contributions of the various members of the parish, it will be well to refrain from invidious criticisms. Each one would do well to ask himself honestly if he has personally given of his material goods and service in proportion to what God has given him during the past year. If one has given in a spirit of love and gratitude to God, his gift has indeed been acceptable in the eyes of God. If any one has given his contributions to his parish in a parsimonious spirit, his gift has hardly been an act of religion and he has lost the most significant part of his gift—the eternal reward promised by Our Divine Lord.

As we look into the year just started, we see more definitely the need for improvements in our school and convent. The prices at present are high, but the spiritual welfare of our children must take preference over material considerations that might be realized by waiting. Also there is need of an organization to give our adolescent young people an opportunity to continue Catholic High school training. It is true it will mean the necessity of sacrifice on the part of each member of the parish. It will mean giving a little more than some have been accustomed to give, but if each member does his share, the burden will not be too great on any individual person. If we give in a spirit of love of God and for God's children, it will be no burden at all. It will rather be a privilege to share with God the material goods that we have the opportunity to earn.

The most important task of each member of the parish, however, is to come closer to the ideal that Our Blessed Lord set for us—"Be perfect as your Father in heaven is perfect". If our parish does not help each one of us to come closer to God in our everyday lives, we as a parish are a failure. And if each one of us does not take an interest in the salvation and sanctification of the other members of the parish, we are personally remiss in fulfilling the command of Christ: "Thou shalt love thy neighbor as thyself".

We wish to express our deep appreciation for the generous self-sacrifice of those who gave of their time and labor for the material improvements about the church, to the School Sisters, the Members of the Ladies Sodality and Altar Society, The Catholic Womens Club, the Holy Name Society, The High School Sodality, the Ushers, Choir and Mass servers.
