BETTER RECEPTION OF HOLY COMMUNION

Reflecting on our recent feasts, and how we can keep them vibrant in our lives over a busy summer, there is no better way than to receive Christ in the Eucharist as reverently and devoutly as possible. The following from Fr Ed Broom, OSV on www.catholicexchange.com (June 9, 2015) may help:

- 1. FAITH:** How easy it is for our faith to decline, to get weak, or even to disappear. Sad to say that the biggest religious group in USA are non-practicing Catholics! Let us pray with fervor: "Lord I do believe but strengthen my faith!" May our faith grow, blossom and flourish until we reach heaven!
- 2. APPRECIATION AND THANKSGIVING:** In relationships, especially in marriages, one of the greatest perennial dangers is to start to take the spouse for granted. The same thing can happen to our relationship with the Eucharistic Lord: we can become accustomed or used to Mass and Holy Communion – even among daily communicants- and start to take the Lord for granted. Let us join our hearts, minds and voices with the Psalmist and acclaim: "Give thanks to the Lord for He is good, for His mercy endures forever.
- 3. CLEAN THE HOUSE:** Make a good sacramental Confession. If you like, a dirty glass pane prevents the sun from entering the room fully. Likewise, a dirtied or sullied soul will block the full and powerful presence of the Eucharistic Lord in His entirety from inundating the soul!
- 4. COME EARLY:** It is doubtful that we would show up late for the last game in the World Series, or a graduation ceremony, or even an expensive and exquisite meal in a glamorous restaurant. Should we not then be early to welcome the King of Kings and the Lord of Lords into our hearts? Let us avoid cutting corners with God.
- 5. REVERENCE:** Moses was commanded to take off his sandals before the burning bush that was a mere symbol of the Eucharistic Presence. How much more reverence we should manifest in front of the Real Presence and the Eucharistic Lord. He is not a symbol but a Real Person!
- 6. MARY'S HEART AND YOURS:** When approaching Holy Communion, humbly beg the Blessed Virgin Mary to lend us her Immaculate Heart so that we can receive Jesus with the utmost purity, humility and burning love.

In conclusion, we should be overflowing with joy and gratitude for the most sublime gift of the Holy Eucharist. The Holy Eucharist is truly and substantially the Body and Blood of the Lord Jesus. There is no greater action we can possibly do while we live on earth than to receive the Eucharist worthily. Jesus consoles us with these words: "I am the Bread of life. Whoever eats my Body and drinks my Blood will have everlasting life and I will raise Him up on the last day." (Jn. 6:55) Heaven is ours if we receive Jesus here on earth with faith and burning love!
