## MISSION TRIP

This summer our youth will be participating in yet another mission trip. This trip is coordinated by the Diocesan Youth office, and is the 4<sup>th</sup> such trip our young people have gone on. This year's trip is to Andrews South Carolina, to help needy families affected by last fall's flooding, when they received over 24 inches of rain in two days. These mission trips are set up to help our young people see a part of our church that goes beyond the borders of a local parish. They see the mission aspect of our church first hand in serving the needs of people without distinction to their faith. They also witness other young people from around our diocese working together to serve others in need, and are themselves a witness to the group they are serving with.

Another aspect of the mission trip is leadership. These young people gain confidence in their abilities, and even learn new skills they might not have realized they possessed. While together in small groups, they are encouraged to reflect on their experiences, and when they return they have simple dinner for benefactors when they speak of their experiences. These are opportunities to enhance their public speaking skills, and other leadership qualities that will benefit them in so many areas of life as they prepare for the future.

Our young people going on this trip have been active in doing fundraising for this trip, or have invested in it from their savings, and each one has skin in the game. However, the cost of the trip is more than we ask them to contribute, and as a way for the entire parish to be a part of this, we will once again use our second collection next week to subsidize this mission trip on the parish level. If you would like to do more, and sponsor a young person for \$250, please let Lana know at St John's rectory or put this information in with your donation next weekend.
