Parish Humane Vitae Study

Last month I mentioned in the parish bulletin that July marked the 50th anniversary of Pope Paul VI's encyclical, Humanae Vitae, in which the Pope reiterated the almost 2000 year old teaching that the use of artificial birth control is a sin. Although the document's message was not new and no Church teaching was changed, the teaching caused a level of controversy throughout the Catholic world that was unprecedented, as it challenged the beliefs of the sexual revolution of the 1960's.

I promised that I would be leading a study group examining the document. With a wealth of recently published materials available, choosing was not easy. I decided to use an excellent study guide written by Cindy Morales and published by Catholic Scripture Study International, and a DVD on the life of Paul VI distributed by Ignatius Press. There will be a total of five sessions lasting 1 ½ hours each. At the first session after an introduction, the video about the life and teachings of Pope Paul VI will be viewed and the guide materials will be handed out. At the remaining sessions, the encyclical will be studied in detail. The sessions will be on be held late on Sunday afternoons so those with children may attend. High school students are encouraged to come for the study. If participants are interested, a potluck meal will be served afterwards. The study will occur during the months of September and October. Even if you cannot commit to all classes, if interest please register and come to as many as you are able.

As I wrote last month, this is an excellent opportunity and time to learn about the basis for the Church's teaching about the dignity of the human person, sexual love and marriage, and the opposition the modern culture has mounted against the Church's age-old stance. The teachings of the Church are understandable, but profound. They are not easily taught in a homily on a Sunday. I promise that you will benefit by understanding them more deeply in order that you might be a witness to your family, your neighbors, our country, and the world
