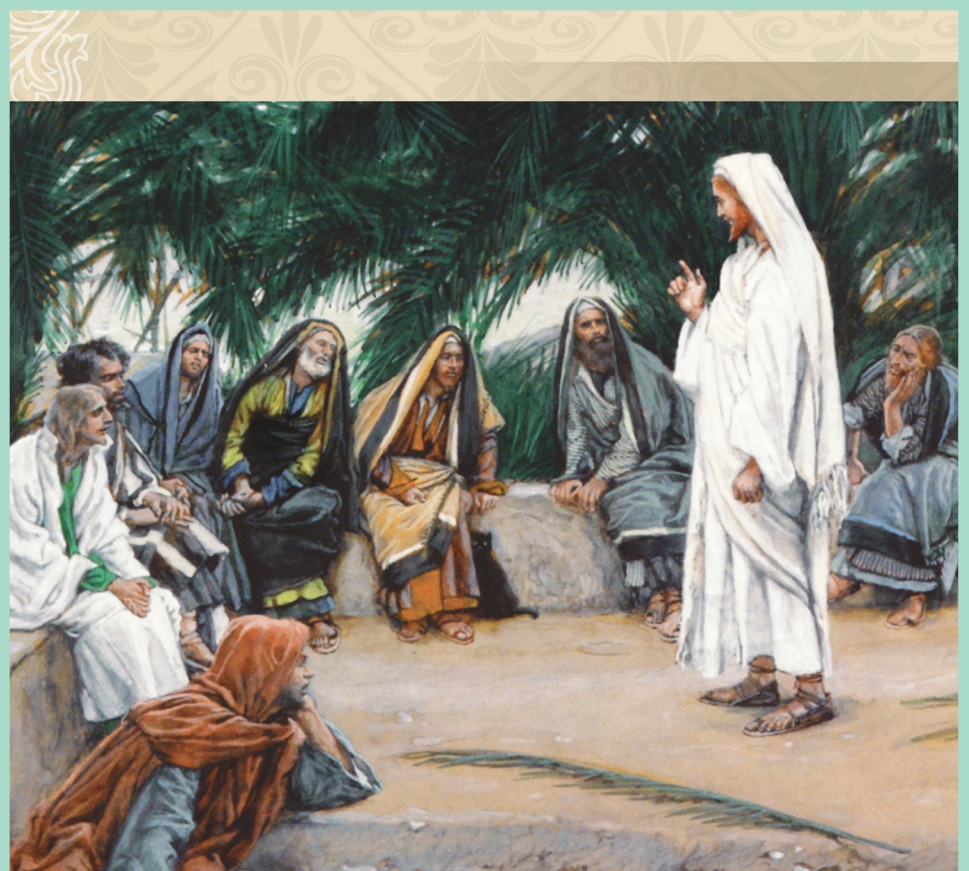

ON-LINE GIVING

We are working with a company (Vanco) to set up on-line giving for Holy Family Parish, Prairie Catholic School and Lil'Saints Day Care. This is something that many parishes have moved to, and we will be doing so over time as well. We will soon have links on our website, www.prairiecatholic.org, as well as instructions on how you can access this payment/donation option. This will be available for our school parents for tuition, trip charges, lunch payments etc., and for parishioners that choose to use this option for regular parish contributions. We will be printing some 'DONATION' cards for those that use this as a way to give and still wish to have something to place in the collection plate during the collection. These will be placed at the entrance of the church, and you will be able to pick one up as you come in and place it in the basket as it comes around. We will then return them to the entrance of the church for the next Mass.

As with anything new, I am sure there will be an adjustment period, but this is something we are excited to offer to our families.
