Dear parishioners and visitors

I want to clarify two things that I have heard since I arrived in July.

Several people have asked why my title is "Monsignor" rather than "Father". I, with several other priests in the diocese, were bestowed this title by Pope Francis after Bishop Callahan had submitted our names to him. It is the Bishop who made the determination after consulting with several groups of priests. None of us knew this was occurring until we were summoned to come to La Crosse for a meeting. The title is an honorary one. There is no distinction in the three hierarchical levels of ordination: deacon, priest and bishop.

The other is how long I will be assigned to Holy Family Parish. It is my plan to remain until I retire which I can in 2024 but I might stay on longer depending upon my health. I am not sure if I will be ready for retirement then because I have always worked. If I run out of work, I usually find something to do; it is hard for me just sit and do nothing. This is my plan which can change depending mostly on the Bishop and the needs of the diocese; my plan and the Bishop's aren't necessarily congruent.

I hope this information is helpful. If the rumors persist, tell the above and say it is a rumor which will be true.
