If you have a loved-one who is a member of the parish not at the two listed above, and if you wish to share their names, please let me know them, and the facilities and locations they are residing. If they are not too far away, I will make every attempt to visit them. However, I have to be honest that I might not be able to see them monthly. I go to those facilities where I know residents are confined and cannot get out.
