Dear parishioners and visitors,

In the midst of coping with the coronavirus, things need to continue. One of these things is the beginning of a new school year. As of right now, the school year will begin for Prairie Catholic School on Monday, August 24th. A plan will be put together and approved by the Bishop before the year begins. The public will be informed in the near future on the procedures which the staff, parents and students must adhere to keep everyone as safe as possible. Always be mindful circumstances can happen which could affect the start of the new year and everything in between.

One change is the Mass time on Tuesdays and Thursday when the students attend Mass. The starting time will be 8:30 AM. A new program beginning this year is to provide breakfast. Students who participate will have it at 7:30 AM so the necessary fast before Mass and receiving Holy Communion is honored. These Masses will be celebrated at St. Gabriel and the first one will be Tuesday, August 18th. It could happen that we will be back at St. Gabriel's by then depending on circumstances. I am looking at changing the Mass time on Mondays (*when is scheduled*), Wednesdays and Fridays to an earlier time. I find that Mass is so late at 8:30 AM, and puts me in a crunch especially if there is a funeral. In the past, there was a weekday Mass at 6:45 AM. I am not sure if people want to come that early but I am open to it or a starting time of 7:00, 7:15 or 7:30 AM. For those of you who will or might attend, please let me know by Monday, July 6th.

The Diocese of La Crosse, through its policies and procedures, seeks to provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reporters of sexual abuse of a child by any diocesan agent (bishop, priest, deacon, employee, religious, vendor or volunteer). Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to Mrs. Karen Becker, Complaint Intake Agent, at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. Alternatively, you can contact Mrs. Becker at 608.791.0179 or intakeagent@diolc.org. The reporting form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse Office of Safe Environment or on the diocesan website at: diolc.org/safe-environment/reporting. Individuals are also encouraged to take their reports directly to civil authorities. Copies of the diocesan policy are available through your local parish and on the diocesan website.
