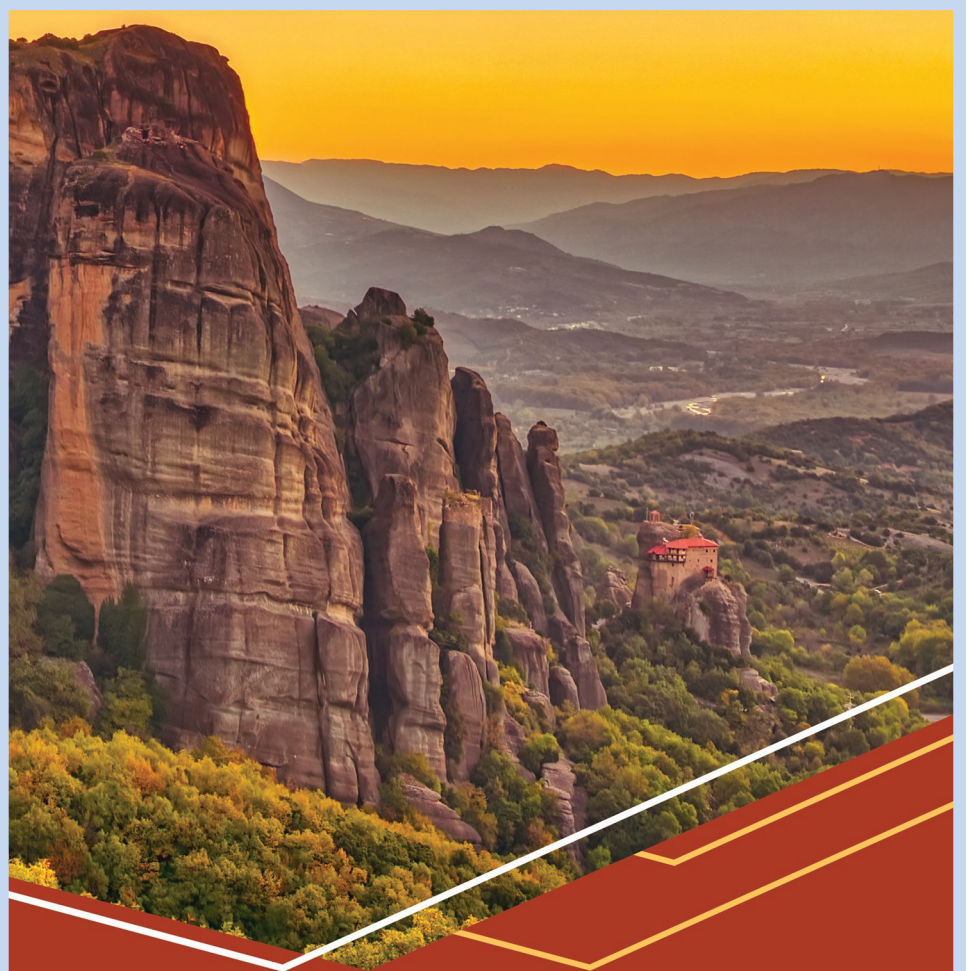

Dear parishioners and visitors,

We have gotten past the first weekend offering public Masses. I know it was a challenge for you and me. This is all new to us so we need understanding and patience until this virus as very much lessened. The main reason for all the restrictions is the Church wants to keep the faithful healthy. Some restrictions come from the Church; others, the government or its agencies. So, please bear with us as we try to gather in sacred prayer the best way we can.

I trust you have read the following information below but I include it one more time in case you have not; it applies to everyone:

Only 25% of the church's capacity can be occupied in order to keep the 6 ft. social distancing. It means there can be only 132 people in church per Mass. Once that number is reached, all those wanting to enter cannot. If anyone has flu-like symptoms, please do not attend; the obligation has and is relaxed until further notice. Please bring your own face mask. Note the limit for weekday Masses will be relaxed beginning June 1st. Also, note that all Masses – weekend and weekday – will be held at St. John for two basic reasons: 1) to concentrate our efforts to sanitize one church building rather than two, and 2) to accommodate more people because St. John's can hold 132 whereas St. Gabriel 100 at the 25% capacity. Once we get past this virus and all pre-cautions, we will return having Masses at both churches. If there is a family who wants a funeral at St. Gabriel's, it will certainly be accommodated.

For the fourth and final try, the dates of these parish events have been set: First Holy Communion: Sunday, June 14th, 12:00 Noon; Eighth Grade Graduation: Friday, June 19th, 5:30 PM; and, Confirmation: Wednesday, July 1st, 6:00 PM. Those receiving these sacraments and recognition have told the number they can invite since the capacity of the church is 132 people. Unfortunately, no others can attend in order to accommodate as many family members as possible.

This is another update to show parishioners where we are in reaching our goal for the 2019 Diocesan Annual Appeal which is \$59,310.00.
