Dear parishioners and visitors,

This the first weekend that public Masses can be offered in church. We are very happy to be back after 2 ½ months. I hope we are all very happy. Yet, please keep in mind there are strict guidelines that all have to follow; it is not like it was before the virus took hold.

Below is what I had written in the bulletin last weekend. I ask you to once again read and take note:

Only 25% of the church's capacity can be occupied in order to keep the 6 ft. social distancing. It means there can be only 132 people in church per Mass. Once that number is reached, all those wanting to enter cannot. If anyone has flu-like symptoms, please do not attend; the obligation has and is relaxed until further notice. Please bring your own face mask. Note the limit for weekday Masses will be relaxed beginning June 1st. Also, note that all Masses – weekend and weekday – will be held at St. John for two basic reasons: 1) to concentrate our efforts to sanitize one church building rather than two, and 2) to accommodate more people because St. John's can hold 132 whereas St. Gabriel 100 at the 25% capacity. Once we get past this virus and all precautions, we will return having Masses at both churches. If there is a family who wants a funeral at St. Gabriel's, it will certainly be accommodated.

Every person has to follow these guidelines. It is simply the way it is until this virus threat is somehow alleviated. Everyone can find fault and not like certain things but we have to follow and enforce what is given to us. All of us will have to practice patience and understanding.
