With much of the attention focused on the coronavirus, other things fell by the wayside which has had lesser or no notice. One thing I want to give is an update on the parish finances. Even though I don't have any concrete numbers, so far this fiscal year has been going smoothly. Since payroll for our employees is every two weeks (*about \$25,000 per time*), money must be on-hand to make it happen. So far, the parish has been making it plus paying bills. As of today, the parish is able to stay current with all its obligations. This happens because you have been supporting the parish in your giving and fundraisers. My sincere gratitude goes to you! Please continue with your support and tithe your financial support giving back to God for blessings to you.

Another is you should have received by now the information on the Diocesan Annual Appeal from the diocese. Please show your support for all the work the diocese does here and abroad. Since the appeal in 2017, our parish has not met its target amount which it used to since it began under then-Bishop Burke. A parish has to have a very good reason why it can't in order to be forgiven its balance. We have been paying the balance to avoid being assessed a 6% interest charge. Sometime soon I will print weekly update on how we are doing so to encourage your support.
