With this trip completed, I have only 16 miles out of @ 21,000 on which Amtrak operates that I have not yet ridden. If everything goes well, I should complete these on the next trip.

This trip was very nice yet there were two eerie scenes: the number of people on the trains, and in Chicago and Washington, DC. Several trains had much lesser people than I thought but the others had more. The greatest surprise was the lack of people especially in the two cities I had mentioned especially in Chicago during the noon hour. A good half of the stores are closed either temporarily or for good. Covid-19 is keeping people home to work and not traveling. Now that President and First Lady Trump have been tested positively, and the number of residents in Wisconsin has spiked recently, the concern is still there. Life in the world has changed since this virus was exposed, and probably will remain for some time.

I had the privilege of being installed as the first pastor of a parish we built in what was once a cornfield. The good news is that it was built with funds donated by all of you my dear friends. You can be proud of what you have done over the past years. God bless you all. With the parish well established and growing my concern is now continuing expansion of Songambe Health Center that will soon be a Class A1 Hospital. As a hospital we will be expected to have a separate children's' ward, an eye and dental clinic, add another refrigeration unit to our mortuary, add personnel, build housing for some of the staff, develop the infrastructure and as I mentioned, provide private rooms.
