Dear parishioners and visitors,

The five dioceses in the State of Wisconsin have announced the obligation to attend Sunday Mass will go back into effect. Each bishop determined when it would be effective in his diocese; Bishop Callahan has designated the weekend of October 3<sup>rd</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> for the Diocese of La Crosse. This means all Catholics are to attend Mass which is one of the precepts of the Church. The exemption is to those with respiratory ailments which the virus could compromise their health.

The churches in our parish will continue to be disinfected after each Mass until further notice. It is encouraged to maintain social-distancing and wear a face-mask until word is conveyed to the contrary. It is anticipated the 25% occupancy will no longer be in effect.

All these things are in-flux which you are most aware. Things change quite rapidly so please keep up-to-date with the information as we are able to pass it onto you.
