Dear parishioners and visitors,

I write this letter today to inform you on some of the financial things that are going on in the parish.

First and foremost is the need to support the parish operational budget. Hopefully, one day in the nearer future the parish will have a budget to show you what it costs to operate. Both the learning center and schools have budgets as dictated by the agencies that license and accredit them. These budgets will make up a good part of the parish budget; most of the work will be done. I estimate that we have over a \$1,000,000 budget. The one item of total income is the weekend collection. Presently, your financial giving is not meeting expenses and we have to take out of savings which will run out. The collection has to go up to make ends meet. Salaries and benefits are the major expenses in a budget, and we should bump-up salaries to be more just.

Secondly, there are building and ground projects that have and should be done to maintain our buildings. Three new furnaces will be installed at St. Gabriel Church. The air conditioning system is over 60 years old there and could cause more problems in the near future. We need to purchase a different pick-up with a snow plow because the present one is rusted out in front and can't plow anymore. If you look around at all buildings, you will find more things that should be done.

I hope you will find this information helpful. There are plenty of needs to address that affect more people than a building which services few or none. The parish has to be prudent on the money it receives and how it is spent. There are lots of things we want but we have to live within our means.

Requests are made more frequently for the weekend Masses than weekday Masses. It is important for the Church to pray for her beloved dead asking the Lord to forgive sin and grant eternal rest.

Now that a semi-normal life has returned after covid, the parish wants to schedule again lectors, Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, and servers for the weekend Masses. If you are interested in any of the ministries, please contact Msgr. Stoetzel at 608-326-6511. It will take time to get back to a full schedule. Presently, only two people are needed to distribute Holy Communion.

The 2020 Diocesan Annual Appeal is over. We fell short of the parish target by **\$8,000.00**. The balance will have to be paid from the general parish account used to meet our financial obligations.

Praise God! Our lives are starting to have a sense of normalcy after a long, trying year. It is with great excitement that we are looking forward to our church reopening and time to deepen our faith. We are starting to order materials and trying to figure out scheduling of our High School Confirmation Program. If you have an incoming Freshman please contact the rectory at 608-326-6511 and sign them up for classes starting this September. We would also like to extend an invitation to ALL high school students who maybe did not start classes but would like to be Confirmed. We would be blessed to walk this Confirmation journey with you in any way we can. Any questions please contact Msgr. Stoetzel or Mary Stoeffler.
