Dear parishioners and visitors,

I have been asked if I can visit the hospital and nursing facilities now that covid has lessened. Whenever I have been called to anoint a Catholic, I ask if I can. As it stands presently, I cannot go to the hospital nor facilities on a regular basis. The local hospital will allow me to visit with the understanding that a patient can have only two visitors per day. I have not been visiting so that family and friends can take precedence. If the patient and/or family request to be anointed and/or confession, I will go; however, it means that I am counted as one of the two visitors. As for the nursing facilities, I will go when asked to give sacraments. Presently, I cannot go to visit monthly as I had been doing. Once the approval is granted, I will resume visitations as I had been doing before mid-March, 2020.

These restrictions might have been given from higher-ups and not necessarily from those on the local-level. I sense the people on the local-level would rather grant the visitations but they are bound to follow the policies given from above, and I am not referring to God but those on the state or national levels of government.

Now that a semi-normal life has returned after covid, the parish wants to schedule again lectors, Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, and servers for the weekend Masses. If you are interested in any of the ministries, please contact Msgr. Stoetzel at 608-326-6511. It will take time to get back to a full schedule. Presently, only two people are needed to distribute Holy Communion.
