Beginning this weekend, the obligation to attend Sunday Mass and Holydays goes back into effect in our diocese.

One weekend Mass must be said for the parish family as stated in canon law. Requests are made more frequently for the weekend Masses than weekday Masses. It is important for the Church to pray for her beloved dead asking the Lord to forgive sin and granting eternal rest.

There are just three days left to complete the 2020 Diocesan Annual Appeal. Here is where we stand as of June 22nd: **Pledged - \$54,410.00** which is **87.16%** of the target amount from **265** parish households. Wisconsin Safe Haven Laws allow parents to relin-
 quish an infant under 72 hours old to any first re-
 sponder, no questions asked. Those first responders
 could be police officers, 911 emergency medical staff,
 or hospital staff members. You do not have to give
 your name or address to the professional accepting the
 baby unless the baby has been harmed, someone is
 forcing the parent to give up the baby, or the baby is
 more than 3 days old. The parent may be asked if they
 are willing to fill out a form, but it is NOT required;
 however, it will help providers give the infant the best
 care. If you wish to learn more about this law,
