Dear Parishioners and Visitors,

At the end of April, I had informed you the parish office at St. Gabriel will be disposed of in some fashion but the land will be retained by the parish for any future use. Here is more information:

The building will be gone through to remove any contents the parish wants. If you are interested in purchasing it, please put it in writing and send it to me at the parish office no later than June 30th. A timeline will be developed when the building is to be removed. Please note that the agreement will include that all material must be removed. In addition, it will be up to the purchaser to fill in the hole with good top soil and seeded. Also note that you must be full insured and must provide proof. Ideally, this is all to be accomplished by Labor Day weekend of this year.

Announcements

The parish secretary, Lana Gratace, is not in the office due to illness. The office will be open sporadically during this time. Please call first (608-326-6511) before coming to make sure someone is there.

Procedures have changed regarding the coronavirus. The recent guidelines from the diocese have eased up some of the restrictions imposed in May, 2020. The one that still has not changed is the reception of Holy Communion. Holy Communion is still one species only: bread. Wine used to become the Blood of Christ is not to be offered at this time. The only two options to receive the Body of Christ are: 1) reception on the hand, or 2) on the tongue. However, please note that if you want to receive on the tongue, you will have to receive after Mass. The priest or deacon will have to sanitize his hands after each single communicant or family to avoid passing on the virus if present. If you want to receive Holy Communion on the tongue, inform the priest before Mass. This procedure will go into effect the weekend of June 5th-6th. Also, holy water

will once again be at the church entrances if you desire to bless yourself beginning the same weekend. **Beginning the weekend of June 26th - 27th, the obligation to attend Sunday Mass and Holydays will go back into effect in our diocese.**

There are two weeks left to complete the 2020 Diocesan Annual Appeal. Here is where we stand as of May 17th: **Pledged - \$53,570.00** which is **85.81%** of the target amount from **258** parish households. Thank you very much to those who have given thus far, and we are counting on the rest to do your part to make it successful. If we do not reach our goal by the end of June, the balance will have to be paid from the general parish account used to meet our financial obligations. So we need your support now!

Please note that Joe and Joanne Prew will no longer be selling booster tickets; Scott and Cindy Sutton are taking on the duty. The parishioners extend their tremendous gratitude for the many years they headed this responsibility. Joe and Joanne thank you for your support, and want you to support Scott and Cindy.
