The end of the fiscal year is approaching on June 30th. With that comes the end of the Diocesan Annual Appeal for 2020. If you have been reading consistently the bulletins, I have been keeping you abreast on how we are doing. Presently, there is \$8,855.00 yet to be pledged and paid; the cut-off is June 30th. Any amount the diocese receives after that date is applied for the 2021 appeal.

I really appreciate all those who have given to the appeal showing your support to the diocesan church which helps the Church locally, nationally, and universally. However, there are a number of our envelope holders who haven't contributed; we need your support. One of the biggest complaints Catholics have is the shortage of priests. Did you know that it costs the diocese minimally \$50,000 per seminarian per year? The appeal, in part, pays for the education of seminarians. So, if Catholics in the diocese want priests, the diocese needs your financial support to the appeal.

The Diocese of La Crosse, through its policies and procedures, seeks to provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reporters of sexual abuse of a child by any diocesan agent (bishop, priest, deacon, employee, religious, vendor or volunteer). Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to Mrs. Teresa Brown, Complaint Intake Agent, at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. Alternatively, you can contact Mrs. Brown at 608.791.0179 or intakeagent@diolc.org. The reporting form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse Office of Safe Environment or on the diocesan website at: diolc.org/safeenvironment/reporting. **Individuals are also encouraged to take their reports directly to civil authorities.** Copies of the diocesan policy are available through your local parish and on the diocesan website.
