### Announcements

Procedures have changed regarding the corona virus. The recent guidelines from the diocese have eased some of the restrictions imposed in May, 2020. The one that still has not changed is the reception of Holy Communion. Holy Communion is still one specie only: bread. Wine used to become the Blood of Christ is not to be offered at this time. The only two options to receive the Body of Christ are: 1) reception on the hand, or 2) on the tongue. However, please note that if you want to receive on the tongue, you will have to receive after Mass. The priest or deacon will have to sanitize his hands after each single communicant or family to avoid passing on the virus if present. If you want to receive Holy Communion on the tongue, inform the priest before Mass. This procedure will go into effect the weekend of June 5<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup>. Also, holy water will once again be at the church entrances if you desire to bless yourself beginning the same weekend.

*If you use a cell phone as your main phone, please inform the parish office of your cell phone number. Thank you.*
