Dear parishioners and visitors,

Since the St. Gabriel Fall Fest is this weekend, it is a good time to update the parish on several projects that are or will be done in St. Gabriel Church and Prairie Catholic School:

Furnaces in church: The three furnaces that used to heat the church developed leaks over the past several years. The concern became that if all three were needed on terribly cold days, there could have been at least one of them failing. All three were replaced costing over \$17,000.00 and are in operation;

Air conditioner in church: During this past summer, the system broke down and was repaired at the end of June, and a complete failure at the end of July. The finance council recommended going with a similar system that was in-place. A plan is being developed so that interested companies can bid on the system we want rather than one a prospective company wants the parish to buy;

Air conditioner in the school basement: In the second week of school, this unit failed. There was a way to get it operating again but it would have circumvented the safety system which could have been very dangerous. Again, a plan is ready on what is needed so competitive companies can bid. The project is hoped to be done early next summer.

Newer truck and plow: A newer model truck and a new plow to go with it were purchased for all the grounds of the parish and cemetery. Many thanks to the Knights of Columbus and the parish cemetery association for purchasing them for the parish!

You see the major expenses on maintenance that needs to be done. One of the projects should be covered from interest generated from the parish endowment trust. The other two will have to come from the parish donating over and above what is generated from tithing. I call upon you to be generous. It is our responsibility to keep up the buildings and grounds.

As a side note, the parish office is closed. All office materials were transferred to the parish office on Wacouta Ave. The building will be cleaned out over time waiting for the next step.
