Dear parishioners and visitors,

The 2021 Diocesan Annual Appeal will be getting underway very soon, and perhaps you have already received information asking for your contribution. Last year, the total amount was \$5,675,035.00 which it has gone up 2% to \$5,788,535.00. The target amount for our parish in 2020 was \$62,425.00; this year, it is \$66,445.00 or an increase of \$4,200.00. Last year, we made our target amount which came at the very end in June. The target amount for each parish is determined by some factors from the Annual Report to the Bishop then divided proportionally among the +150 parishes in the diocese. The amount fluctuates every year depending on the total amount set and how each parish did based on these factors.

I ask for your financial support again on the appeal. The monies given supports many projects in the diocese and universal Church. Several programs that our parish provides have benefitted receiving money from grants that the appeal funds. Also, if our parish goes over the target amount, that money is returned to the parish which helps us in the parish operational budget. If we do not reach or go over the target amount, the parish has to pay for the difference out of its funds used for payroll and paying bills.

When you receive the information from the diocese, please pray on what you can give. I will be giving my contribution soon which I plan to give \$1,000.00. I hope you will be very generous with your contribution showing to God your gratitude for the blessings given to you.

LaCrosse Conference on the Natural Christian Family

On Saturday, November 6th, a conference titled "Fruitfulness On the Land -Celebrating the Natural Christian Family" will be held at the Faith Lutheran Church (LCMS), 1407 Main Street in LaCrosse. The speaker is Dr. Allan Carlson, a historian of the family, who recently retired as a history professor at Hillsdale College. Earlier in his career, he taught at the Catholic University of America. He is a founding member of the World Congress of Families, and throughout his career has published many articles and books on pro-family topics. The conference is being sponsored by friends of the Fellowship of St. James, a group consisting of Protestant, Orthodox, and Catholic Christians who share a strong belief in the doctrines of the Nicene Creed and traditional Christian moral teaching. Check in is at 9:00 am with the talks beginning at 9:30 and ending at 4:00. Lunch is provided, and a nursery and program is provided for children. Cost is \$10 for adults.
