Dear parishioners and visitors,

It is time to reveal the prediction from *The Old Farmer's Almanac* for the new year beginning November 1st. With all the sophisticated equipment in today's world, the almanac can predict the weather with good accuracy. However, last year was poorer, which claimed 75% in comparison to the usual 80%; however, that isn't bad.

So, here is the prediction. When it states areas in the region, we are located in the northeast corner:

Winter will be colder and drier than normal, on average, with the coldest periods in mid- and late December, early and late January, and early to mid-February. Snowfall will be below normal in the north and above normal in central and southern areas. The snowiest periods will be late December, early January, and mid-February. April and May will be warmer and drier than normal. Summer will be hotter and rainier than normal, with the hottest periods in early and late June and early to mid-July. September and October will be slightly warmer and rainier than normal.

The last spring frost: May 12th The first autumn frost: September 28th

I hope this will be helpful to all of us, especially those who farm and garden.
